Few guardians expressed concern about campus cleanliness, various services and overall campus environment.	Special attention is given and taken note about the various suggestions regarding overall campus environment improvement from guardians of the students in parent-teacher meetings.
Most respondents are satisfied with library facility.	Library Management System software upgraded to next advanced version to facilitate students. Library collection has been enhanced to support the academic and research needs of the students and faculty.
More than 22% students stated that hostel facility is not satisfactory.	Hostel building is getting old and authority is trying to provide facilities as far as possible.
Very few guardians felt that campus/hostel is not completely ragging free.	The issue was investigated and found that such responses resulted from lack of proficiency in English and confusion regarding use of language.
5% respondents found that computer/ ICT facilities are not available for ICT based teaching to the teachers.	Repairing and maintenance of pre-installed ICT facilities have been regularised as far as possible.
Very few respondents found computer facility not adequate.	More computers were provided to different departments for academic purposes.
Few students and guardians felt that improvement is needed in overall teaching experience and office service.	Teaching and non-teaching staff have been informed about the feedback. They are in continuous process to improve their performance.
Some guardians expressed concern about overall development of their ward.	Sports infrastructure has been improved for students.
More than 71% teachers feel that college provides adequate funding and support for maintenance of laboratory equipment, computers etc.	Various laboratory equipment has been purchased for science departments like Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Botany and Physiology.
