Resolution of the IQAC meeting held on 09.12.2022

The meeting of the IQAC was held at the Principal's chamber from 01:00 m onwards. In the meeting, based upon the agenda, the following resolutions were taken-

1. The resolutions of the previous meeting was read and confirmed.
 2. In the Academic agenda, the IQAC recommends the following may be taken up by the College authority for further proceeding-
 - a. Introduction of add-on courses by various departments, eg.- certificate/add-on course in drama, spoken Sanskrit, spoken Arabic, spoken English etc.
 - b. More emphasis on procuring student internship.
 - c. A registered Alumni Association. Alumni feedback be given importance
 - d. Ensuring that the Department maintain record of study report on study tour/excursion/ project of the respective department along with geo-tagged photos and other relevant documents for every participating student and Teacher escort.
 - e. Identification of slow and fast learner through internal examinations/class test/ base level test/open book exam. Separate emphasis on the two groups and special tutorial classes/ remedial to cater to the slow learners to keep them, at pace as part of participative learning.
 - f. Look upon the feasibility of mentor-mentee system at least for the Honors students as a formal start
 - g. Request the departments to conduct regular student seminar apart from that conducted centrally. Keeping geo tagged photo record for each event.
 - h. More emphasis on implementation of ICT techniques. Checking the feasibility of allotting at least a certain number of classes of each department in the smart classrooms in the College
 2. It was informed to the IQAC that the AQAR for 2017-18, 18-19 and 19-20 has been successfully submitted. The AQAR for 2020-21, 21-22 and 22-23 to be completed with urgency.
 3. In the miscellaneous section, it was proposed that the cycle stand be extended, beautification of the campus and more emphasis on green campus be given through plantation of trees and gradual replacement of conventional lighting sources by LED. It was also proposed that the College consider providing incentive to Academic staff for paper presentation in international seminars/conference etc.
