

Accessibility of the Teacher in and outside of the class 491 responses















Gender equality for students and staffs is assured by the College 69 responses










Principal/ Head of Institution is approachable and cooperative 69 responses







Data, documents, records are maintained systematically by the College 69 responses




Capability of the Faculty members are fully utilised 69 responses








Are you satisfied with the classroom/ laboratory/ ICT facilities provided by the College? 163 responses




Is the College campus / hostel (if availed) free from ragging? 161 responses







Are you satisfied with the Library facility of this College? 164 responses




### **Findings:**

- 92% parents are happy with the progress of their wards.
- Almost all parents agree that teachers are very cooperative.
- More than 85% guardians are satisfied with the classroom/ laboratory/ ICT facilities provided by the college.
- More than 52% respondents are satisfied with hostel facility, 40.8% opted for 'not sure'. Parents do not feel that ragging happens in campus or hostel.






Worth of syllabus in catering to the needs of industry/society \* 74 responses




Interpersonal relationship with colleagues, subordinates, supervisor \* 74 responses















### **Observations and Conclusion:**

Analysing the questionnaire, it can be noted that the employers are highly satisfied with the curriculum and overall experience with our pass out students working with them. Almost all respondents find the adequacy of the curriculum and the skills students acquired are very much satisfactory. Our students are also equipped with soft skills like communication skill, leadership quality, punctuality and interpersonal behaviour, which are very much required for the overall enhancement of the workplace environment. This fact is being highly reflected from the feedback report from the employers. Few respondents have shown concern about the conduciveness of the syllabus for the readiness of the students towards recruitment, but this matter is mainly controlled by the university. Although the overall feedback from employers is highly satisfactory, there is always scope on further improvement of academic environment of the college.

### **Action taken:**

- Feedback from employers on the performance of graduates are collected for better understanding of college curriculum and activities. On the basis of feedback report different actions are taken.
- Students are encouraged to participate in different sports activities that keeps them physically as well as mentally fit to face real world workplace challenges.
- Jersey set has been given to Kabaddi team for achieving Championship in Inter-College tournament.
