Department of History Report On Mentor-Mentee Meeting 2023-24 Session

Mentoring students (i.e., with proper documentation) by the faculties of History Department is formally started in the 2022-23 session. But the teachers of this department played the role of mentor from the joining in this College by following old customs of this department. Normally by discussing with the students with their daily life, health, financial condition and family environment, we short out the problems of the students. After knowing their problems we tried our best to solve these. In most of the cases their problems have been solved even by providing tiffin, books, money for paying examination fees and a health check-up. But all the above activities had not been documented because we were not informed to do so.

From the session 2022-23 we started to documenting these activities as the instance of the institution. Dr. Amiya Ghose, Head of the Department, took the initiative to mentoring mentees of Semester IV and arranged three meetings— 27.3.2023, 4.5.2023 & 23.6.2023. (last meeting is under our previewed session period, please see page no. 3)

Later as per guidelines issued by college authority, responsibility of mentors were decided in the departmental meeting and after this Mentor-Mentee Meet are being recorded by each mentor in their respective register to assess the activities of the mentors in future. Detected Problems and Advices of Mentors (in short):

1) It was detected during these meet that most of the mentees have been feeling insecure about their future after completion of their B.A. Course on the ground that in West Bengal after 2016, there is no advertisement for recruitment in different departments and unemployment is an acute problem for last eight years and at the same time appointment of teachers in all level and other sectors have caused serious agony in the mind of the mentees. They also discussed others problems- regarding infrastructure of the college, transportation cost etc.

Mentees are advised not to think over about above problems at this stage, but mentees must have to complete their studies at first with all confidence and thereafter prepare themselves for competitive examinations for getting job and to enjoy college classes with attention to acquire sound knowledge in the respective subjects brushing aside all the above problems.

2) On day to day taking classes it is sometimes pointed out that girl students feel tired and mentees disclosed their health problems.

To overcome the problems of girl mentees it is suggested not to keep their belly empty for more than three hours during College days and to take at least one iron tablet and vitamin tablet and to take some food after an interval of three hours. Mentor in many cases provided with such food and vitamins as per their requirement by providing some fund from mentor's own cost and in reality in mofussil colleges mid day meal programme may be introduced by the government for avoiding malnutrition of girl mentees.

3) Examination phobia is found in respect of negligible number of mentees who generally come from poor village families. Mentor always keeps information about their deficiency and guides them personally by providing substantial support both book materials and some fund.

Mentor has formed a very close relation with all the mentees to support them mentally and physically and in reality they secured good result in every semester.

Suggestions	Waking up Early- Many students feel that sleeping longer will belp them to concentrate in the examination hall. This is a wrong idea. Waking up early in the morning will keep the students shead of their time, and they can complete their breakfast, check their belongings, and do last time revisions.
	Checking the Venue and Reaching the Time- Just like answering the questions correctly, it is also essential to reach the venue on time. If someone rushes in to find the venue and arrives late, it will impact the examination. So checking the venue beforehand and arranging a ride to the examination hall is necessary.
	Go to the Toilet Before the Exam Starts. It is essential to be prepared before you start with the exam, going to the toilet and drinking water should be completed before the exam begins. Going to the hathroom within an hour may not be allowed in the exam hall.
	Read the Question Paper- Before frantically starting with the writing, it is essential to read the question paper thoroughly. Checking the question paper will give a fair idea about everything the examinee needs to complete within the time frame. Moreover, checking the question paper also helps the student to get an idea about the questions they want to attempt in the first hour. This
	is one of the essential tips for exam day that students tend to forget. Writing Down the Names and Filling the Answer Sheet Correctly- Before starting with the answers, students are required to write their names, ronumbers and all the other necessary information needed by the school or the board conducting the examination. Unfortunately, many students tend to prove information that causes a lot of trouble for both the students and the examiners. So, the students should pay attention and complete the information correctly.
Follow up	Online follow up (WhatsApp chat and over phone) strategies: 1. Review: Briefly go over key concepts. 2. Emphasize Positivity: Highlight strengths. 3. Logistics: Ensure the student knows exam details. 4. Healthy Habits: Remind about sleep, food, and hydration. 5. Strategy Reminder: Recap effective strategies.






