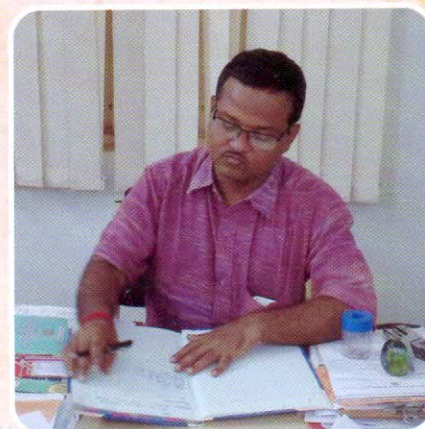

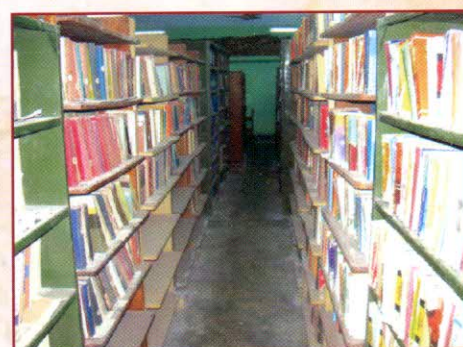

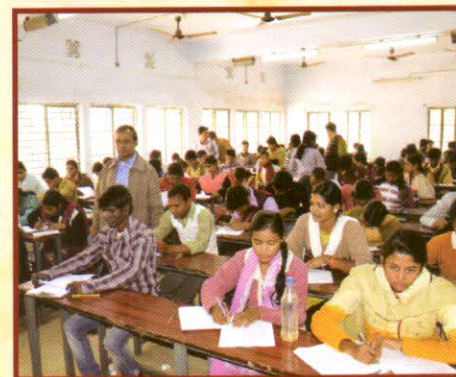
Location:

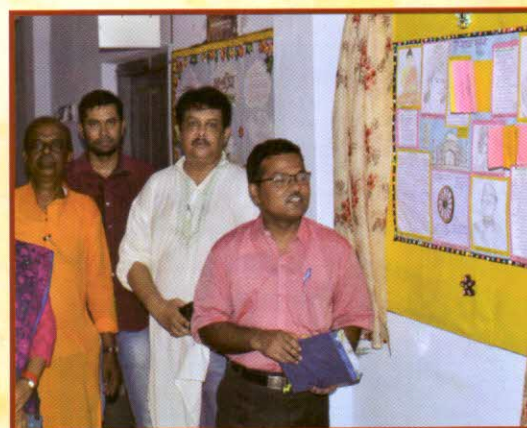
